We encourage work that introduces new ideas, concepts, research, and understandings to the field, as well as analysis of both successes and failures.

All abstracts must be received on or before June 16, 2023.

When submitting an abstract, please choose one track and two sub-topics that apply:

Abstract Topics

- Typhoid
- Paratyphoid

All abstracts should be submitted through the electronic submission system and will be reviewed by an abstract review panel. Please read the following guidelines carefully before submitting your abstract:

- Abstracts can only be submitted through the online portal
- Abstracts must be written in English
- Limit text to no more than 350 words
- Avoid the use of abbreviations within the text
- Title should not exceed 150 characters
- List the authors and affiliations (limit of 7 authors)
- Do not include tables, figures, or illustrations
- Word (.doc) and PDF files are acceptable

The abstract must be submitted in the following format:

Background: State the purpose and objective of the research or program, as well as a description of the problem being analyzed

Methods: Describe the basic design of the study, including the study period, setting, design, population and techniques used for data collection

Results: Report the key findings that address the purpose of the study. Highlight any statistically significant differences or trends found in the data

Conclusions: Summarize the overall findings and explain the significance and future implications of the results

The following review criteria will be used in scoring abstracts:

- Is there a clear background and justified objective?
- Is the methodology appropriate for the objectives?
- Are the results important and clearly presented?
- Are the conclusions supported by the results?
- Does the study contribute to the field?
