

By the Numbers

Typhoid conjugate vaccines (TCVs) are:

- ✓ World Health Organization (WHO) recommended for ***routine use in children*** in countries with a high burden of typhoid and/or high rates of drug-resistant typhoid.
- ✓ ***Eligible for support*** from Gavi, the Vaccine Alliance (Gavi).

WHO PREQUALIFIED TCVs (2 eligible for Gavi support)

79-85%

vaccine efficacy in children in Phase 3 studies conducted in typhoid endemic countries

nearly **150** million

children vaccinated with TCV through introduction campaigns

Projected 2/3

reduction in ***drug resistant typhoid cases and deaths*** over the next 10 years in Gavi-eligible countries.
